

Manual for New Equipment and Speaker ARCHs

Gingko Audio is proud to introduce the new and improved ARCHs for equipment and speakers.

The new ARCHs are made of a layered maple wood with superior vibration control property.

This material is stronger and more consistent, plus the smoother surface allows us to offer ARCHs in five finishes: standard black, natural, white, cherry and mahogany.

We also optimize the design for a lower profile and wider optimal load range thus obviating the need for multiple sizes for different loads. The new ARCHs will be offered for Equipment and Speakers weighing more than 15 lbs. For very heavy equipment and speakers weighing more than 200 lbs., we recommend that the customer consider stacking the new ARCHs. The new design allows for convenient stacking by using the right size stainless steel bolts and nuts/washers through the holes in the ARCHs (see pictures).

The new ARCHs are sold in sets of four. Standard black finish sets retails for \$169 a set for equipment and \$199 for speakers (which includes standard M6 bolts, nuts, and washers). Write us at gingko@gingkoaudio.com if your speakers require bolts other than M6. Custom finishes of natural, white, cherry, and mahogany cost an additional \$30 for a set of four.

We recommend the Mini-ARCHs for equipment and speakers weighing less than 15 lbs. They are sold for \$299 for a set of 12.

Tips for setting up the new ARCHs

- As three ARCHs are required to balance under equipment or speaker, use three when possible for any load more than 15 lbs. Four can get you up to 200 lbs. For more than 200 lbs., use the stack two ARCHs as shown.
- You can use the ARCHs under the feet of the equipment or spikes of the speaker. Place the tip of the spike in the drilled hole on the ARCH. Another alternative is to replace the feet or spikes with the ARCHs using the same screws that come with the feet or spikes. Yet another alternative is to place the ARCHs directly under the equipment chassis or speaker bottom as long as the equipment does not touch the shelf or ground.
- Experiment with the number and positioning of the ARCHs under the equipment to achieve the sound you prefer. But don't obsess over too much fine-tuning to the point of taking away the joy of just listening to music.
- The ARCHs are warranted for one year from date of purchase against manufacturing defects.
